**Sego Resources Announces Two Drill Holes Over 0.4% Copper**

Sego Resources reports that the 2008 diamond drilling program on its Miner Mountain porphyry copper/gold project near Princeton, BC has intersected significant copper and gold mineralization. A total of 10 holes were drilled. The first four holes were drilled in the Regal Zone and confirmed that this zone is the result of extensive post mineral slide activity. Upslope on the Granby Zone drilling has indicated the presence of copper and gold mineralization of grade similar to that found by the 2008 trenching program. (See News Releases April 24, May 12, June 5 and June 20-2008) Of the 6 holes drilled in the Granby Zone, all contained anomalous gold and copper with three holes yielding the intersections indicated below. It should be noted that holes MM-08-04 and MM-08-09 were lost in mineralization at the depths indicated due to difficult ground.

The company is planning Titan 24 IP and further drilling for 2009.
